

**Fraternal Order of Eagles Scholarship
Aerie #1981 Fullerton, NE**

Description

The Fullerton Order of Eagles Aerie #1981 sponsors a scholarship to be awarded to a male graduate of Fullerton Public Schools each year. It is the intent of the Aerie to help defray the cost of furthering education in the hope of a student developing their full potential and becoming a concerned and productive member of society. The scholarship award is \$350.

Rules

1. Officials of Fullerton Public Schools shall be responsible for providing the notice of the award early in the beginning of the second semester prior to senior graduation.
2. The award shall be determined by a formally written resume to be submitted for final consideration no later than April 1st of the current year. Each year an alternate will be selected in case of decline or change in eligibility.
3. The selection and final approval of the scholarship award shall be determined by the Fullerton Order of Eagles Aerie #1981.
4. The scholarship award in the amount of \$350 shall be awarded to a student who is a graduating senior of Fullerton High School planning to further their education in a post-secondary education program.
5. The information pertinent to this scholarship (description, rules & criteria) may be obtained from the Fullerton Order of Eagles Aerie #1981 or Fullerton Public Schools.
6. The monetary award will be forwarded to the recipient when she has presented a receipt of full or partial payment of tuition as evidence of enrollment in the school of choice. The receipt must be presented to the Auxiliary in person or by mail so that the award may be given.

Criteria

The student must submit a resume that includes the following information:

- A. Name, address, phone number.
- B. Intentions for further education, or in other words, where you plan to further your education and what you plan to major in.
- C. Responses to the following questions:
 1. The Fullerton Order of Eagles Aerie represents "People Helping People." What have you done to help your community, church, and school?
 2. What have you learned from the experiences you have just described?
