

Thad Hellbusch Memorial Scholarship (Utility Lineman)

I. Special Provision

- A. The economic value of the annual scholarship will be \$1000.00. However, under the accords, this value may be changed from time to time by the Trustees, upon majority vote. However, the value will never exceed the value that could invade the principal of \$20,000.00.
- B. Payment of scholarship will be made directly to the financial aide office of the institution the recipient attends.
- C. An alternate shall be named when available. Funds of the scholarship shall go to the alternate should the recipient not enroll in a post-secondary institution by January 1st of the following year.

II. To be eligible to receive this scholarship, an individual must satisfy the following criteria:

- A. Be a graduating senior or a graduate that live in the Fullerton, Nebraska or Belgrade, Nebraska area.
- B. Priority will be given to 2nd year college students
- C. Have lived in the above stated geography for two or more years.
- D. Carry a 2.0 grade point average in highschool.
- E. Attend an accredited post-secondary school majoring in Utility Line study.
- F. Complete and file an application (promulgated and approved by the Selection Committee) to highschool counselor on or before March 15. All applications will be forwarded to the Selection Committee on or before April 15th.
- G. The students selected to receive the Thad Hellbusch Memorial Scholarship annually shall be eligible to receive the scholarship, regardless of the recipient's awards from other scholarships.

III. Selection Committee

- A. Officers and Executive Board of the Cedar River Bikers Organization.
- B. Any other appointee of a majority of the above or an appointee of the appointees of the majority of the above, the new appointees preferably being a new member of the Executive Board of the Cedar River Bikers Organization.

IV. Criteria for Selection

- A. The selection committee shall give consideration to the following criteria in determining the recipient of this scholarship.
 - Scholarship 15 points
 - School Involvement 10 points
 - Community Involvement 5 points
 - Character 5 points
 - Statement of Purpose 5 points

V. Presentation

- A. This scholarship will be presented annually at the Commencement exercise for the recipient.

VI. Revision

- A. Guidelines for this scholarship may be reviewed periodically and may be revised by the selection committee above indicated.
